

Truck Mod Rules

Truck Modified (TM) is an exhibition class for the TVR SCCA RallyCross program. TM will be scored as any other class for the season championship.

1. PURPOSE

- a. To allow an exhibition class of trucks to participate in TVR SCCA RallyCross events while competing with like vehicles. The spirit of this ruleset is to allow for a broad range of similar trucks to compete with each other.
2. All vehicles will follow the Modified Category of the current SCCA RallyCross rules unless otherwise defined or restricted in section 3.
3. Allowances and restrictions in addition to the Modified Category rules:
 - a. Tires – DOT legal tires and rally tires are allowed. UTV, tractor, farm, and heavy equipment tires are prohibited. Tire size is unrestricted.
 - i. Dual rear wheel configurations are prohibited.
 - b. All vehicles must be of body-on-frame construction.
 - c. Must have a truck bed that is behind the passenger compartment and separate from the cabin of the truck:
 - i. Truck bed must retain bed sides and must remain recognizable as the manufacturers make and model when viewed from the side. Bed floors are not required to be installed.
 - ii. Tail gates are not required to be installed.
 - iii. Flat beds, utility beds, and other non-factory beds are prohibited.
 - d. Vehicles should not be larger than a ½ ton truck.
 - e. All vehicles must be RWD.
 - f. Factory lifted suspension vehicles are prohibited such as Toyota Tacoma Pre-Runner, Ford Ranger Edge, etc.
 - g. Vehicle lift kits (suspension or body lifts) are strongly discouraged. The vehicle should generally be wider than tall when measured at the highest point. The intent is to ensure vehicles have a center of gravity and suspension design that will not encourage rollover.
 - h. Truck or Ute type conversions of vehicles are prohibited.
4. Vehicles will be inspected for class eligibility prior to the drivers meeting during events. Any questions about class eligibility will be determined by the event master. Any vehicles that are found to be outside these class rules will be moved to the appropriate SCCA Rallycross vehicle category.

a. WAIVERS

- i. Waivers will be considered for individual vehicles in the spirit of the rules above. Waivers must be requested via the event master prior to the drivers meeting on the day of an event.
- ii. Vehicles may only request waivers for 3(b) and 3(f) above. No other waivers will be permitted for restrictions and allowances listed in section 3. Waivers must be requested prior to the drivers meeting at any TVR SCCA event.
- iii. Any waiver granted will remain for the duration of the current TVR SCCA RallyCross season, provided no major vehicle modifications are performed.
- iv. Vehicles denied waivers will run in their respective SCCA RallyCross class, as defined by the SCCA RallyCross rulebook.
